## LEATHER UPHOLSTERY CARE GUIDE

From our fabrics to our fillings, at The Cotswold Company we go to great lengths to use only the highest quality materials. Our range of leather sofas and armchairs are made from a top-grain leather, finished to enhance its natural surface markings and colour variations to give each piece its unique appearance.

## FABRICS

Due to the production methods of our leather, you may notice a waxy film on the surface of the leather when your product is first unpacked. This is part of the specialist finishing process and will absorb into the hide with use, creating a smooth shine. With time, the natural textures and markings will deepen to give a beautiful, aged appearance. Simply rub gently with a dry cloth to accentuate the shine.

We hope you're pleased with your new sofa or armchair and that it's settling in nicely. As your new seating has never been used before, it may take a little time to soften and feel as lived-in as the one you may have tried in store. To help prolong its life, we've put together a few care tips to help ensure it remains looking its best for many years to come.

## OUR UPHOLSTERY CARE PLAN

Confident in the time and care taken to produce every piece of our upholstery, we offer a five-year care plan across the entire range. Accidental damage and accidental staining cover starts on the date of delivery of the item and lasts for five years. The plan will end if the item(s) is replaced following a successful claim, as detailed in the Terms & Conditions.

## CUSHION FILLING



All leather sofas with removeable seat cushions are filled with a mix of fibre and feather around a foam wrap. We recommend rotating and turning the cushions regularly for ongoing support.



## LEGS

If you're placing your new sofa on a wooden floor, we advise using felt pads or castor cups to protect it. Similarly, when moving your sofa try to avoid dragging it as this can damage the legs and joints, and your floor too. Instead, lift the sofa from the base on either end, and gently position into place.

Damage to the sofa frame can occur on uneven surfaces, so be sure to place it on a level and solid surface, using felt pads if needed. Please double-check the feet are in their correct position before sitting on your furniture.

To help ensure your sofa feet continue to look as good as new, give them a dusting with a soft cloth and a mild wood-friendly detergent or polish every now and then. Please note - avoid using polish that contains silicone as this can dull the finish of the wood over time.

Once a month we recommend you check that the feet of your sofa are tightly screwed in as this will help prevent any damage being done by loose fittings.



## MAINTAINING YOUR FURNITURE

**Regular maintenance is important in order to keep your piece looking its best.**

- Wipe gently with a soft, dry cloth to keep your item free of surface dirt and dust.
- Noticeable stains can be wiped with a clean, damp cloth. Try to blot any spillages straight away to avoid lasting damage. Taking care not to soak the leather or to rub the leather too hard and always finish with a dry cloth after cleaning.
- Never use detergents on your leather. Consult a specialist leather upholstery cleaner if your item becomes badly soiled or stained.
- The leather finish does not require nourishing so avoid using any maintenance products.
- Be careful to avoid any sharp objects such as belt buckles, studs, keys or pets' claws. These can all cause wear and tear to leather.
- To avoid risk of fading, keep your sofa or armchair away from direct sunlight.
- Place away from direct heat or radiators.
- As comfy as your new sofa is, please don't sit on the arms or back!

## FIRE SAFETY

Please note that the foam and fibre in our sofa cushions and the upholstery fabric is treated with fire-retardant chemicals. This can give our sofas a slight odour; but don't worry, this will dissipate after a few days of use and with good ventilation.
